Box Hill

After four rounds of low attendance and last week's washout, it was good to see some solid numbers out at Box Hill last weekend. Altogether there were sixteen OS athletes competing, and it was good to welcome debutants Will Huggett (U18 sprinter) and Lyndon Green (U16 sprinter) to the club. Another bonus was the return of all-rounder Rob Belton after an absence of several years.

The afternoon began a spectacular run by Pete Simm in the open 3000m, which saw him winning division 1 and running his fastest time in three years. Then followed a wave of 100m heats, with OS having five junior and four senior sprinters in action. Jackson Finlay and Will Huggett were particularly impressive, while Attila Baranyay continued his good form of earlier rounds. Not surprisingly, the U18 squad ran a good time for the 4x200m relay later in the afternoon.

Messrs Wheeler, Belton and Marshall scored valuable points in the field events, although the javelin results are not yet available because of a problem with AV's results program. Final points on the AV website suggest that the U18's finished second in their division and div 2 fifth, but the latter may change when Andrew and Rob's javelin points are included.
