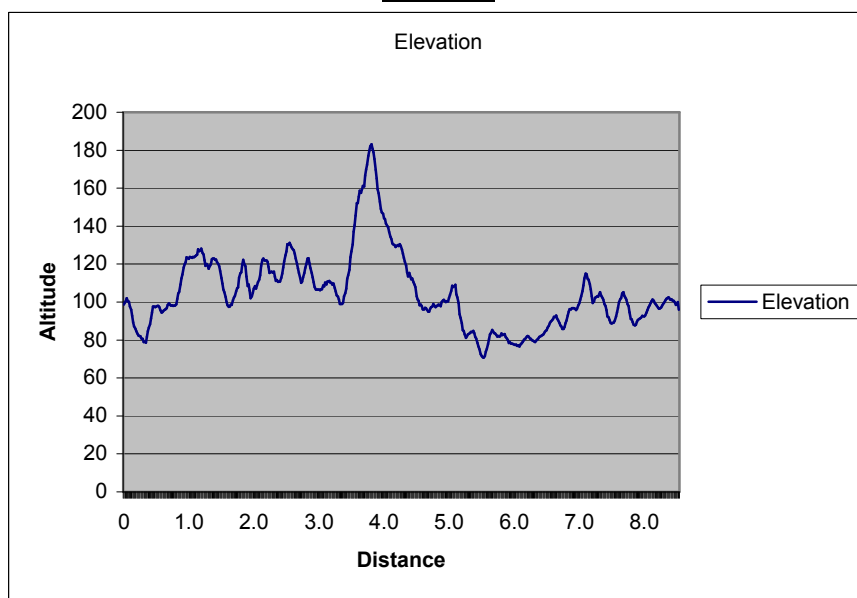
Handicap

It allows you to map runs, view altitude, save maps and heaps of other little cool features. I mapped the Hare and Hounds course and derived this graph from the data. It shows that the big hill is a massive 80m high!
