## Hooley Scratch Results

It was a poor turnout from the Old Scotchies for the Hooley relay, but nonetheless, there were some great performances. **Darcy Long, Peter Simm** and **Rob Schwerkolt** all ran under 11 minutes. A super effort. Year 12 student and captain of the schoolboys cross-country team, **Angus Hope**, ran just over 12 minutes on both occasions. In Division 2, **Sam Curry** had a personal battle for best performance of the day between themselves, with plenty of banter being thrown around the course. **Gerry Voukelatos** was very happy with his negative split. **Sam Curry** had the largest negative split of the day with 15 seconds... so was he trying on the first lap or he just needed a lap to warm up? ## Hooley Relay Results

The division 1 team put in a great effort at the Hooley relay, finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> behind Xavier and Wesley. That's right, no Haileybury, which means that yet again they have failed to win the grand slam. This is the first time we have beaten Haileybury since the Cooke-McClelland in 2004. The race was very exciting, with Old Scotch and Wesley exchanging the lead, before Xavier brought out some guns and got in front. **Angus Hope** ran brilliantly against **Nick Harrison** from Wesley, and **Pete Simm** and **Darcy Long** picked up 3<sup>rd</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> fastest times of the day overall. I got a bit confused when **Rob Schwerkolt** finished for us, as a Haileybury runner was in front. Rob pulled a move around the last corner that Michael Schumacher would have been proud of, taking to the steepest part of the hill, and with 3 swift strides got in front. This however was the second Haileybury team. But still, an awesome kick. The division 2 team came a respectable fourth.

The time of 89:10 is about middle of the road for Old Scotch times in the last 11 year. But in the last seven years, it is the second fastest time (last year being our fastest). The 1999 team, which holds the record for this race, is featured below. Paul Patrick, who ran the fastest time of 9.53 for the event in his first leg, obviously decided this wasn't fast enough, and ran 9 seconds faster on the second leg. PHENOMINAL!
