### Hare & Hounds Handicap - 16<sup>th</sup> May

A cool day greeted the runners at Berwick for a traditional cross country race. Eighty five athletes attempted this tough 8 km course organised by the Lucas family since 1969. Old Scotch fielded 14 runners, and Lisa Lightfoot and Graham Gray volunteered as marshals on the course. It was great to see some of our summer athletes also competing in the winter season competition.

### **Handicap results**

Robert Schwerkolt finished 7<sup>th</sup> overall, having passed 76 runners along the course and only being passed by two runners. Peter Dodgshun, Tamami Koike and David Lightfoot all finished within the first 25 places.

### **Scratch Results**

The standout performance for Old Scotch was Robert Schwerkolt who was 4<sup>th</sup> fastest on the course. David Lightfoot continued his impressive season, placing 12<sup>th</sup>, followed by Nick Wallace-Smith (26<sup>th</sup>), Jon Holmes (28<sup>th</sup>) and Stuart Facey (38<sup>th</sup>). David improved by 7 minutes 28.8 seconds on last year's time!

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### Ken Orchard Memorial Handicap Race – 23<sup>rd</sup> May

On a sunny and windless afternoon, 107 athletes assembled outside the Powerhouse boatsheds at Albert Park Lake for the 10km handicap event. Old Scotch was represented by 15 athletes.

#### **Handicap results**

The top handicap placings for Old Scotch were Peter Dodgshun (8<sup>th</sup>), Robert Schwerkolt (22<sup>nd</sup>), Jon Holmes (26<sup>th</sup>), Tarquin Oehr (32<sup>nd</sup>) and Tamami Koike (33<sup>rd</sup>).

#### **Scratch results**

Robert Schwerkolt was again our top runner placing 6<sup>th</sup> overall. He was followed by Chris Taylor (17<sup>th</sup>), Mark Purvis (24<sup>th</sup>), David Lightfoot (26<sup>th</sup>) and Tarquin Oehr (32<sup>nd</sup>). Tamami Koike was our best female runner (77<sup>th</sup>) with an improvement of 2 minutes 40 seconds on last year's time.
